## Inclement Weather

## 10 Punch Guest Pass

### January 2nd–15th Only \$30

Don't miss out on getting your discounted ten punch guest pass! The Club is offering the pass for \$40 through March 31st. This is a \$40–\$60 savings off of the regular guest fee price! We encourage you to purchase as many cards as you like at the reduced rate. Starting April 1st, the card may still be purchased for \$60. All non-members of the Club, including out-of-town relatives, are considered guests. Passes are for guest use of the clubhouse and pool only; they do not count towards green fees.

## Nanny, Babysitter, or Caregiver Privileges

Members of the Club at Town Center may purchase a babysitter's card for \$100 for use by their nanny, babysitter, or caregiver (N/B/C) of their minor children listed on the account. The N/B/C must accompany the children they are watching in lieu of the parents. The babysitter's card must be presented upon check-in for Club access. The card is only valid for one person. The N/B/C may not use the card to gain access to the facility independently. If they attempt access without the children of the account the card will be confiscated. If parents arrive at the

facility, then the N/B/C must pay the applicable guest fee and abide by the Club's maximum guest limit on visits. N/B/C's children are considered guests of the host member family and must pay guest fees. The card is valid for the current calendar year only and may be purchased by the member each year. The card is the property of the member, not the N/B/C.

## Guest Privileges

A guest is defined as a person not registered as a member of the Club, but who uses the facility while being accompanied by a Club member. A member may bring a maximum of six guests per visit. Members must make arrangements with management for groups larger than six guests.

Guest fees are as follows for a maximum of ten visits: \$10 per adult guest; \$8 per child guest (under age 18).

1. All guests must be accompanied by a member of the Club while using the Club facilities unless permitted otherwise herein. The Club reserves the right to set times when a guest may use the Club facilities without being accompanied by a member.
2. Guests must be checked in and paid for at the front reception area or any amenity check-in area (such as golf or pool check-in). The Club reserves the right to require identification of each guest.
3. Guests shall be entitled to use the Club facilities in accordance with the privileges of membership of the sponsoring member.
4. It is the intention of the Club to accommodate guests without inconvenience to other members, therefore, the Club reserves the right to limit the number of guests that may accompany a member on any given day and the number of times a particular guest may use the Club facilities in any membership year. Each guest is allowed a maximum of ten visits to the Club each calendar year.
5. The sponsoring member is responsible for the conduct of their guest(s) while at the Club. If the manner, deportment, or appearance of any guest is deemed to be unsatisfactory, the sponsoring member shall, at the request of the Club, cause such guest to leave the Club facilities.
6. The Club may deny, withdraw, or revoke a guest's privileges at any time for reasons considered sufficient by the Club in its sole and absolute discretion.
